

POLICY FOR COOKIES

To make this site work properly, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device. Most big websites do this too.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to “remember” your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size, and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don’t have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

How do we use cookies and various technologies?

Some of our pages use cookies to remember: your display preferences, e.g. brightness or character size, if you have already responded to a pop-up survey asking you if the content was useful or not (so as not to ask you the same question again), your password, whether you have agreed (or not) to use cookies on this website. Also, some videos embedded in our pages use a cookie to gather statistics on how you got to this point and which videos you visited.

- We may also receive information from our newsletters that are emailed to you to find out if you have opened or forwarded the newsletter or if you have clicked anywhere on its content. This information informs us about the effectiveness of our newsletters and helps us to ascertain that we are sending you the information that you will find interesting.
- We may also receive information to promote advertising messages that may be relevant to you and your interests. The information can also be used to adjust the frequency with which ads appear and help us adjust the ads you receive and evaluate their effectiveness.
- We may receive information when you choose to log in to social media from your account profile, including photos.
- Demographic data, unique identifiers such as phone number, mobile device identification for physical location.
- Information about your buying behavior and your preferences that you have on our website.
- We may have access to information about you from third-party sources and online platforms.
- We may also assign to relevant service providers the installation and use of cookies on behalf of the Hellenic Capital Market Commission for the purposes mentioned above.
- We do not collect sensitive personal data concerning you without your consent. Enabling these cookies is not necessary for the operation of the website but, through them, you will have the potential for better browsing. You can delete these cookies, or block access to them, but if you do, certain features of the website may not work well.
