ANNOUNCEMENT

Athens, 27 May 2026

The Hellenic Capital Market Commission informs investors that:

- The purported online trading platform "<https://solver99.com>" do not belong to an entity that is allowed to provide investment services in financial instruments, as outlined in Section C of Annex I of Law 4514/2018, and/or hold investor/client money, in Greece.
- The purported online trading platform "<https://solver99.com>" do not belong to an entity that has applied for and received a crypto-asset service provider's authorisation from the Hellenic Capital Market Commission, in accordance with Article 62 of Regulation (EU) 2023/1114 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 31 May 2023 on markets in crypto-assets, or to an entity that has a passport to provide crypto-asset services in Greece in accordance with Article 65 of Regulation (EU) 2023/1114 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 31 May 2023.

The Hellenic Capital Markets Commission draws investors' attention to the need to assess the companies (with which they are doing or intend to do business) regarding their authorisation and supervision status.

Specifically, they should verify whether such companies are authorised, by visiting the website of the Hellenic Capital Market Commission or of the corresponding supervisory authorities of other EU Member States.
