MoU signed between the Bank of Greece and the Hellenic Capital Market Commission

The Bank of Greece and the Hellenic Capital Market Commission have strengthened their collaborative framework by signing a new Memorandum of Understanding.

The MoU was signed yesterday, 25/11/2024, at the Central Building of the Bank of Greece by BoG's Governor **Yannis Stournaras** and the Chair of the Hellenic Capital Market Commission **Vasiliki Lazarakou**.

The new MoU replaces the previous one from 2009. Taking into account the latest provisions of the current legislation and building on the already strong culture of synergy between the two authorities, it aims to clearly define the methods of collaboration, information exchange and provision of mutual assistance in a way that ensures the optimal exercise of their respective responsibilities and duties.

The key provisions outlined in the MoU include:

- supervisory and regulatory matters, as well as issues related to the restructuring of the financial sector and the reporting of statistical information,
- specification of the format and overall cooperation between the two parties,
- the channels and frequency of communication and information exchange,
- cooperation and consultation on regulatory matters,
- conducting on-site inspections,
- holding meetings between representatives of the two authorities.
