PRESS RELEASE

The Board of Directors of the Hellenic Capital Market Commission (HCMC) at its **897/20.11.2020** meeting decided:

- To approve the prospectus of the company "PG NIKAS AVEE" for the public offer of up to 13.288.535 new common, nominal, with voting right shares with cash payment and with right in favor of existing shareholders and the admission to trading of the new shares in the “under surveillance segment” of the regulated market of the Athens Exchange.
- To impose a fine of € 20,000 on "ALPHA BANK SA" for the infringement of the provisions of article 10 par. 1 of Law 3340/2005, as supplemented by the provisions of articles 2 par. 1 and 3 par. 1 of the Decision of the Board of Directors of the HCMC with no. 3/347/12.7.2005, in conjunction with article 6 par. 1 of Law 3340/2005, due to the delay in the disclosure of inside information in the process of bank’s share capital increase in 2015.
- To impose a fine of € 20,000 on "EUROBANK ERGASIAS SA" for the infringement of the provisions of article 10 par. 1 of Law 3340/2005, as supplemented by the provisions of articles 2 par. 1 and 3 par. 1 of the Decision of the Board of Directors of the HCMC with no. 3/347/12.7.2005, in conjunction with article 6 par. 1 of Law 3340/2005, due to the delay in the disclosure of inside information in the process of bank’s share capital increase in 2015.
